

Helping Homeless Children and Families in North Idaho



Youth Guidelines

1. One adult chaperone is needed for every five youth ages 12-18.
2. Adult chaperones are encouraged to raise funds for a box but it is not mandatory.
3. Children under 12 years old should be with a parent.
4. Registration is due prior to the event.
5. Registration packets will include a group form to fill out listing chaperones and kids. The night of the event each participant will get a bracelet, a t-shirt and a ticket for the **Turbo Runner** drawing.
6. All registrants are encouraged to set a goal for maximum pledges. We suggest \$125.00 total per participant.
7. Money collected goes in a packet with pledge sheet on top. The packet has a number in the right hand corner that will correspond to registration sheets.
8. Seal the envelope with pledge sheet on the front and money on the inside and bring to the event.
9. Checks need to be made out to Family Promise of North Idaho (or FPNI) with CBC '16 written on the memo line.
10. Plan to get your own boxes – area appliance and furniture stores will have them.
11. Prizes will be given for Most Creative, Most Durable, and a variety of other categories.
12. No alcoholic beverages, electronics (IPad, IPod, or computers) or pets allowed.
13. Enjoy our entertainment, soup kitchen style dinner, and breakfast.
14. Quiet hours are from 10:00 p.m. – 6:00 a.m. Security will be available during quiet hours and these times will be enforced for the comfort of all in attendance and surrounding neighbors.
15. The free breakfast will be served from 6:00 a.m. to 7:30 a.m.
16. Take down will begin at 6:00 a.m. and completed by 8:00 a.m. All cardboard will be recycled.
17. Responsibility and respect are the hallmarks of good neighbors. Leave your space sparkling clean.
